

US Engineering Industry M&A Overview

- The engineering industry unites civil, environmental, infrastructure and geotechnical engineering and includes surveying, and testing to deliver efficient, integrated solution
 - Civil and infrastructure engineering lead the design and construction of large-scale projects, supported by geotechnical engineering for foundational assessments, environmental engineering for compliance, and surveying for precise land measurements
- Engineering companies are actively looking for consolidation to combine resources, integrate new technologies, and simplify workflows, resulting in improved project management and lower operational costs
- Notable transaction in the market include:
 - Cornerstone Building Brands, Inc's acquisition of Mueller Inc for \$480 Mn
 - Parsons Corporation's acquisition of BCC engineering,
 LLC in an all-cash transaction valued at \$230 Mn

Key Trends Shaping Engineering Industry M&A

PE investors are increasingly acquiring engineering firms in infrastructure, utilities, or water/wastewater projects drawn by steady demand and favorable trends

Engineering firms are merging with or acquiring businesses in allied sectors to provide more comprehensive solutions

Companies in the environmental and civil engineering sectors are merging to meet sustainability goals

Engineering firms are acquiring companies that provide complementary services such as project management, environmental consulting, or risk management

Firms are increasingly acquiring technology-focused companies that specialize in digital tools like GIS, drones, BIM, and AI for real-time monitoring and project optimization

Technological Integration and Automation

Engineering firms are increasingly adopting advanced digital tools like Building Information Modeling (BIM), Geographic Information Systems (GIS), drones, AI, and automated systems to optimize design



Smart and Resilient Infrastructure

There is a growing trend toward developing "smart" infrastructure using sensors and data analytics to improve efficiency and sustainability and resilient infrastructure to withstand natural disasters, climate change, and other challenges



Innovation in Construction Materials and Techniques

The focus is shifting toward new, more sustainable construction materials and methods. Innovations such as 3D printing, modular construction, and sustainable materials (e.g., recycled concrete, low-carbon steel)



Aging Infrastructure

Aging infrastructure presents opportunities for businesses and engineering firms. As roads, bridges, and utilities reach the end of their intended lifespans, the need for modernization and innovation becomes increasingly urgent

US Engineering Services Market




